

SUPPLIES LIST (FOR HOMEWORK)

BRUSHES

Flat brushes #2, #4, #6 and #8 (Silver Bristlon is a good brand) and one round signing brush (#00)

PAINT

Lukas, Golden or Liquitex acrylic paint

- Cadmium Red deep
- Alizarin Crimson
- Cadmium Yellow (or Cadmium Yellow Medium)
- Cadmium Yellow light or Lemon Yellow
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cerulean Blue or Pthalo Blue
- Raw Umber
- Titanium White
- Quinacridone Magenta (optional)

PALETTE

I like the stay wet <u>Masterson palette</u>, the big one. Palette measures $16^{"}W \times 12^{"}D$. If you don't have it or don't want to invest on this yet, a paper palette works too, a large one.

SUBSTRATE

20 6×6 inches hardboard panels

1 16 x 20 inches hardboard panel (if you paint on a standing easel)

OTHERS

One roll of paper towel

View Catcher

Color wheel

Water Spray

Bucket for water

Scotch removable Mounting Putty (1 packet) or duck tape (1 roll)

Small clip on lamp (not required)

You'll need an easel (ideally standing). If you don't have one, wait until our first class so we can talk about your options. An easy an inexpensive plan B is a 2 inch (or larger) binder, or an extra roll of paper towel. Trust me, I'll show you in class;)
